

WHAT QUESTION IS URGENT TO ASK?

HOW CAN WE BE TOGETHER AGAIN?

Facing multiple crises, this action seeks to provoke dialogues, reflections and encounters that allow us to visualize ways to re-establish ourselves collectively, especially within a context of constant social, political, economic, public health and environmental transformation.

This Toolkit will help make your question visible in order to share it with your community, network and the world. The set of printed letters will provide the material for you to write the question and install it in different spaces and on multiple surfaces.

WHAT DO WE NEED TO KEEP MOVING FORWARD?

To accomplish this activity you will need:

- This guide
- The set of printed letters that accompanies this guide
- Double sided tape
- A mobile phone or a digital camera to take high quality photographs.

WHERE TO INSTALL YOUR QUESTION?

Choose a site that is accessible for you and where the meaning of your question is at stake.

It can be at your window or a wall at home, in a common area of your office, workshop or place of work. Or perhaps it can be the street, glued to a wall, on the ground at a park, or on the steps of a stairwell. You can also organize with your family, friends and co-workers to hold the letters with your hands, and through your bodies to present this question in public.

We have explored all of these alternatives which have allowed us to share questions in communal spaces that are necessary to activate public discussions.



WHAT QUESTION IS URGENT TO ASK?

HOW TO INSTALL YOUR QUESTION?

If you are going to install the letters on a wall or any vertical surface, if possible, organize your question in a paragraph (more like a square and less like a long horizontal line). If you decide to place the letters against a corner, or if you choose to hold them in your hands with a group of friends, keep in mind that the longer the sentence, the further away you will need to stand to photograph it, making your letters appear smaller.

HOW DOES YOUR QUESTION LOOKS LIKE?

Photograph your question in order to share with others. A question that is located in a specific context has the potential to induce new relations between the components of the scene, adding complexity to the meaning of your action.

Of all the photographs you take, we ask you that at least one of them is taken directly in front of the question so that the entire question appears in frame, centered, and with no deformations due to perspective. Try to ensure that nothing interferes with the reading of your question.

WHAT DOES MY QUESTION PROVOKE?

Once you have shot your photographs, return to the section of this website where you began this exercise, and upload the photographs you wish to share.
